4. Strathpeffer visit (May 18-20th 2018)

Colin told the choir of his recce visit to Strathpeffer and the Dingwall Choral concert in May 2017. He was very impressed by the beautiful Strathpeffer Pavilion as a performing venue.

a) Accommodation

The Bay Highland Hotel is a large Victorian building in a perfect location for us adjacent to the Pavilion. It should be fine to accommodate the choir, offering a very good price for a weekend stay. Bill has already paid the deposit to secure an initial 25 rooms. This number could be altered slightly if needed. Bill will contact the hotel management to see whether they could provide a buffet meal for us prior to the concert on the Saturday, as the timing of their regular dinners would not fit with our concert timing.

b) Concert(s)

Mark has already been in touch with John Thomson, the Dingwall Choral conductor, to start to plan a programme. The suggestion at present is that both choirs perform individually with maybe one joint piece.
